



Practice with Passion Blog Submission Guidelines

Please adhere to the following guidelines when submitting an article for publication in our blog.

Credentials:

Submissions are accepted from practicing attorneys, recruiters, and law students. Please provide a current resume, bio, or link to your LinkedIn page, and an email address with your submission.

Subjects:

We accept articles that provide readers with advice or non-fiction stories. Articles must be related to lawyers and law students, including but not limited to in-house practice, large and small law firms, public interest law, legal technology, or law school. If you are not sure if an idea for an article is what we are looking for, please email the address below with your idea. Also, if you have an idea for a regular column for the blog, please get in touch.

Advice Submissions:

Article submissions that provide advice or tips must contain useful, relevant content for readers.

Non-Fiction Story Submissions:

Article submissions that tell a story should be from the author's own personal experience or perspective. Stories should avoid using organization, company, or law firm names. Stories should also avoid individuals' full names (unless it is yourself) or identifiable characteristics, and profanity.

Originality:

We prefer original content for article submissions but will consider work that has appeared elsewhere on a case-by-case basis when you send us a link to the original content via email.

Language, Length, and Format:

The submission must be in English, and should be 500-1,000 words.

Acknowledgement:

Please provide a short bio and an optional headshot to accompany your article.

Review Process:

An in-house editor will review article submissions as they arrive. The review process generally takes anywhere from one to four weeks. Authors whose submissions have been chosen for publication are notified as quickly as possible via email. If you do not receive a reply within four weeks, feel free to submit your article elsewhere.

Article Revisions:

We may edit your article at our discretion for grammar, flow, readability, and for consistency with PracticePro's editorial style guide. This includes article titles.

Where to Submit:

Please email your article to submissions@practicpro.cc with the appropriate subject line – "Advice Submission" or "Story Submission." Microsoft Word or Google Docs is preferred.

Article Destination:

If accepted, your article will appear in our blog and be mentioned in several of our social media accounts including Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter.
